Los Angeles session guitarist David Boswell is scheduled to release his third album, *I Like That*, January 12, 2009. With guest stars that include jazz innovator **Jimmy Haslip** (Credits: Yellowjackets and an extensive list of major industry leaders), smooth jazz saxophonist **Nelson Rangell** (Credits: Eric Marienthal, David Sanborn, Jaco Pastorius and more), rock drummer **M.B. Gordy III** (Frank Zappa, REO Speedwagon, The Doobie Brothers, Yoko Ono and more), and new age pianist **John Boswell**, *I Like That* is a fresh release that infuses high energy compositions with phenomenal musical chemistry.

The talent and experience of each musician is evident as each track unfolds. While Boswell's guitar is the primary voice, each individual voice melds into an unpredictable musical stew. It's contemporary instrumental jazz as it's meant to be—free and wild.

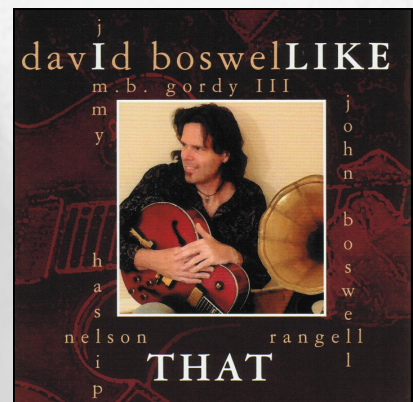

Multi-instrumentalist David Boswell's guitar calling came after he attended a Pat Metheny concert as a teenager. He would go on to attend the Grove School of Music in Los Angeles and play with various rock bands. Having studied under Pat Metheny, Jack DeJohnette and Dave Holland, his diverse musical influences include a love of be-bop and the styles of John Coltrane, Keith Jarrett and Miles Davis.
